The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground, and the several courses established by means of offsets from the lode lines. All tie lines were run directly on the ground.

The S.W. Cor., Sec. 26, T. 3 N., R. 42 E., M.D.B. & M. is a porphyry stone 4 x 6 inches, 12 inches above the general surface, chiseled with two notches on the East face and one notch on the south face. This is the nearest standing corner of the public survey that can be found and identified. Intersections of the West boundary of Sec. 26 with claim lines of this survey were calculated in accordance with the returns of the public land survey.

Slip Lode, unsurveyed, N.W. Cor. is a pine post, 4 inches square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above the ground.

Lady H, No. 2 Lode, unsurveyed, N.W. Cor. is a pine post 4 inches square, showing 3 ft. above ground.

Courses and distances of west side line of Lady H Claim is N. 12 31' E., 1412.3 ft.
