

## Other Improvements.

Tunnel, mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 3, N 25° 20' W 240 ft., 4X6 ft., running N 62° W., 65 ft. to face, claimant unknown.

Tunnel, mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 3, N 74° 30' W 326 ft., 4X6 ft., running N 43° W., 34 ft. to face, claimant unknown.

Cut, mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 4, N 7° 45' W., 311 ft., 4 ft. wide, 10 ft. face, running N 10° E., 20 ft to face, claimant unknown.

Cut, westerly end of which is on line 4-5, 101 ft. from Cor. No. 5, 5 ft. wide, 5.5 ft. deep, running N 60° E., 12 ft. to easterly end, claimant unknown.

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 Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificate of this claim are due to errors in the latter.

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 Report.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 3, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B. and M, is a porphyry stone, 7X12X10 ins above mound of stone, chiseled with 3 notches on the east and west faces respectively.
