

Course of longer side N. 2° 24' E. Fred Walker, Claimant.

Navacowich House, Two story brick, the S. W. Cor. of which bears S. 83° 34' E. 92.8 ft. from Cor. No. 2. Size 44x22 ft. Course of longer side N. 2° 24' E. Navacowich Claimant.

I N S T R U M E N T.

This survey was made with a Berger Mining Transit No. 6. The courses were deflected from a true meridian, determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 660 ft. steel tape.

R E P O R T.

This survey was run directly on the ground, and the several corners established at the exact corner points. All tie lines were measured directly from the corners.

The 1/4 Cor. between Secs. 18 and 19, T. 5N., R. 28 E. M.D.M. is a sandstone, 12x18x24 ins. marked 1/4 on the North face, set in a mound of stone.

SUR. NO. 69, OPHIR LODE:

Cors. Nos. 1, 3 and 4 are 2x8 ins. posts, showing 3 ft. above ground, in mound of stone, and marked U.S.S. No. 69 Ophir Mine, and corner number. Cor. No. 2 is not set, and its position is computed from the position of the other corners.

SUR. NO. 70, EVA LODE:

Cors. Nos. 1 and 4 of this lode are 2x8 ins. posts, showing 3 ft. above ground, marked U.S.S. No. 70 Eva Mine and corner number. Cors. Nos. 2 and 3 of this lode are mounds of stone, the posts having been destroyed.

SUR. NO. 3941, TEXAS LODE:

Cor. No. 4 of this lode is a 4 ins. square post, showing 3 ft. above ground in mound of earth and stone.

DOCTOR LODE; Unsurveyed.
