

Undivided 1/4 interest to Elephant Head lode \$350.

No.1. The discovery tunnel of the Lime Point lode, the mouth of which bears N 66°50'E 575 ft. from Cor.No.1, Lime Point lode, 4 X 6 ft., running S 58°E 46 ft. to face.

Value \$460.

No.1. The discovery cut of the Elephant Head lode, the mouth of which bears N 88°E 256 ft. from Cor.No.2, Elephant Head lode, 4 ft. wide, 9 ft. face, running N 27°W 18 ft. to face.

Value \$100.

No.1. The discovery cut of the Rio Vista lode, the mouth of which bears N 4°20'E 445 ft. from Cor.No.1, Rio Vista lode, 4 ft. wide, 7 ft. face, running N 48°W 15 ft. to face.

Value \$100.

No.2. A tunnel, the mouth of which bears N 33°15'E 594 ft. from Cor.No.1, Rio Vista lode, 4 X 6 ft., running N 62°30'W 54 ft. to face.

Value \$540.

Other Improvements.

A frame bunk house, the Southeast corner of which bears N 23°33'E 793 ft. from Cor.No.1, Elephant Head lode, 12 X 32 ft. Course of long side N 48°W.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a C.L.Berger Mining Transit No. 3246. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at eastern elongation. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and 660-ft. steel tapes.
