

Report.

The S.E. Cor. Sec. 33, T. 31 N, R. 43 E, M.D.M. is a quartz rock, 5 X 14 ins., showing 16 ins. above ground, chiseled with three notches on the east and three notches on the west edges. A mound of stone, 3.5 ft. base and 2.5 ft. high bears east 5 ft.

Sur.No. 1842, Ethel C lode:

All of the corners are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I found the courses of the lines of this survey to be as follows: 1-2 N $89^{\circ}05'E$ 396.7 ft. instead of S $89^{\circ}23'E$ 400 ft.; 2-3, N $0^{\circ}55'W$ 1498.37 ft. instead of N $0^{\circ}37'E$ 1500 ft.; 3-4, S $89^{\circ}05'W$ 396.7 ft. instead of N $89^{\circ}23'W$ 400 ft.; 4-1, S $0^{\circ}55'E$ 1498.37 ft. instead of S $0^{\circ}37'W$ 1500 ft.

Sur.No. 1843, Washington lode:

All corners are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I found the courses and distances of this survey to be as follows: line 1-2, N $69^{\circ}40'E$ 598.1 ft. instead of N $70^{\circ}E$ 600 ft.; line 2-3, S $19^{\circ}47'E$ 1487.2 ft. instead of S $20^{\circ}E$ 1500 ft.; line 3-4, S $69^{\circ}39'W$ 586.36 ft. instead of S $70^{\circ}W$ 600 ft.; line 4-1, N $20^{\circ}14'W$ 1487.34 ft. instead of N $20^{\circ}W$ 1500 ft.

Sur.No. 1844, East Lake Superior lode:

All of the corners are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I found the courses and distances of the lines of this survey to be as follows: line 1-2, N $69^{\circ}46'E$ 596.8 ft. instead of N $70^{\circ}E$ 600 ft.; line 2-3, S $20^{\circ}E$ 1498.08 ft. instead of S $20^{\circ}E$ 1500 ft.; line 3-4, S $69^{\circ}43'W$ 591.75 ft. instead of S $70^{\circ}W$ 600 ft.; line 4-1, N $20^{\circ}11'30''W$ 1498.62 ft. instead of N $20^{\circ}W$ 1500 ft.
