Survey No. 4167

This survey was made with an Engineer's level mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 100. and a 300 ft. steel tapes.

Report

- No. 1 The claim lines were run directly upon the ground, also all of the tie lines were run direct on the ground.
- No. 2 The N. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 15 T. 27 S. R. 64 E. Mount Diablo Base and Meridian is a blue line stone rock 12 ins. long, 7 x 8 ins. in mound of rock, chiseled "4" on South side. This is the nearest corner which after diligent search could be found, without question as to its correct location.
- No. 3 The corners of the locations were all 4 x 4 inch posts with mounds of earth and stone, 3 ft. above ground with the claim name and corner location painted thereon.
