Instrument.

The survey of this claim was made with a C.L. Berger and Sons. No. 2 transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 500 and a 100 foot steel tape.

Report.

The lines of this survey and the several ties given were run directly upon the ground.

The S.W. Cor. Sec. 2, T. 16 N. R. 62 E. M. D. B. and M. is a line rock showing 5 x 7 x 8 ins. above the ground chiseled with 5 notches on the South side and 2 notches on the East side.

✓ The West $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of said Sec. 2 is marked by a pile of rock and a flag pole. This is commonly accepted as the corner although I was unable to identify it by the usual marks.

✓ Cor. No. 7, Sur. No. 4111, Dickson No. 2 lode is a post 5 ins. square scribed D-2-4111-4.
