

SURVEY No. 4181

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with an A. Lietz light mining and mountain transit. The corners were deflected from a true meridian as determined from an observation on Polaris. The distances were measured by a 500 and a 50 foot steel tapes.

REPORT.

I found the N.W. Corner of Section 4, T.30 N. R. 24 E. M.D.B.&M. to be properly marked and witnessed as in field notes of survey of West boundary of said section, by a stone 9"x24" in a small mound of rock. I found no workings nor monuments of any kind upon this claim except the workings placed thereon by the claimant.

I found Corner No. 2, Survey No. 3953, Red Mountain Placer, R.B.Henderson, Claimant, to be a pine post 4 ins square, standing $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground in a mound of earth and properly scribed.

Corners No. 3&4, of the same Survey, No. 3953, are marked by juniper posts 4 ins square and 6 ins. in diameter respectively, each standing 3 ft. above ground in mounds of earth and properly scribed.

I found lines 2-3 and 3-4, Survey No. 3953, correct as approved.

There are no ledges nor indication of mineral of any nature, except gypsum, embraced within the boundaries of this claim.
