

Survey No. 4183.

- OTHER IMPROVEMENTS-

A shaft which bears from Cor. No. 4 Hudson lode S. 83° 30' E. 340 ft. 4x6 ft. 8 ft. deep.

A trench the center of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Hudson lode N. 31° 30' E. 410 ft. 2 ft. wide, 15 ft. long, 2 ft. deep. Course N. 70° E.

Claimants of these improvements unknown.

- INSTRUMENT-

This survey was made with a No. 4 Berger and Sons transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

- REPORT-

The S.W. Cor. Sec. 28 T. 2 S. R. 43 E. M. D. M. to which connection is herein given consists of a stone showing 5x12x12 ins. above ground, marked 4 notches on east, one notch on south side, and X on top.

Connection was made to this corner for the reason that it was the nearest corner that could be identified.

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 2713 Whipperwill No. 3 lode consists of a post 4 ins. square showing 2 ft. above ground,

scribed 3-2713. Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 3101, Big Dyke lode consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2 ft. above ground, scribed 3-3101.

All intersecting lines were found upon the ground as given in the foregoing field notes.
