direct upon the ground.

The West side line of the April Fool Fraction lode was run direct upon the ground, and the corners of each location established by running all the end lines direct upon the ground.

The discovery monuments, ties to conflicting claims, and improvements were located by means of offsets from these lines.

The Traverses from the Section corners to base. Nos. 1 is submitted in a separate report herewith.

The M.E. Cor. Sec. 4, T. 31 N., R. 42 E. of M.D.M. is a limestone, set in the ground, and 6 x 8 ins. by 8 ins. above ground, and chiseled with 3 notches each on E. and W. edges, and with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2.5 ft. high alongside.

The M.E. Cor. Sec. 33, T. 32 N., R. 42 E. of M.D.M. is an iron post, 10 ins. high, set in the ground with mound of earth, stamped  $\frac{28}{33} \frac{27}{34}$  and T. 32 N. R. 42 E. with a pit dug in each Sec. cor. and a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 18 ins. high on W. side.

The N. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 33, T. 31 N., R. 42 E. of M.D.M. is an iron post, 14 ins. high, set in the ground with mound of earth, stamped  $\frac{28}{33}$  and with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high alongside.

Cor. No. 2, Sur. No. 4196, Independence lode, is a pine post, 4 ins. square, 3 ft. high, properly set and scribed I.D. 2-4196.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 4196, Independence lode, identical with S.W. Cor. Honey Lode No. 4 lode, unsummed.
