## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A shaft which bears from Cor.No.4 N.58°W. 46 ft. 4x7 ft.500 ft.deep. Goldfield Merger Mines Company claimant.

## INSTRUMENT

This Survey was made with a Berger and Sons No.4 transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft.steel tape.

## REPORT.

The S.W.Cor.Sec.36 T.2 S.,R.42 E.,M.D.M.to which connection is herein given consists of a stone 5x7x10 ins.above ground, chiseled 1 notch on east side and 5 notches on west side.

Cor.No.5 Sur.No.2197 Lucky Boy lode, Cor.No.6 Sur.No. 2217 Red Top lode and Cor.No.1 Sur.No.2505 Vinegorone lode consists of a post 4 ins.square showing 2½ ft. above ground, scribed 5-2197, 6-2217 and 1-2505.

Cor.No2 Sur.No.2564 Last Chance lode and Cor.No.2 Sur.No.2565 Kewana No.2 lode consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2½ ft.above ground, scribed 2-2564 and 2-2565.

Cor.No.2 Sur.No.3626 Polo Verda lode consists of a post 4 ins.square showing 1 ft.above ground, scribed 2-3626.

Cor.No.4 Sur.No.3843 Velvet lode consists of a post 4 ins square showing 2½ ft.above ground, scribed 4-3843 V.

Intersecting lines were found upon the ground as given in the foregoing field notes.

Cor.No.4 Sur.No.2196 Clermont lode consists of a post 4 ins.square showing 2½ ft.above ground scribed 4-2196.
