

## Survey No. 4202, continued

A cut, the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 4, Honey Comb No. 5 lode, S.  $34^{\circ}59'E$ . 283.9 ft. 5.5 ft. wide, 5 ft. face, running S.  $4^{\circ}30'W$ . 11.7 ft. to face

A cut, the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 6, Honey Comb No. 5 lode, S.  $20^{\circ}12'N$ . 364.4 ft. 4.5 ft. wide, 3.0 ft. average depth, running S.  $9^{\circ}31'W$ . 22.0 ft. to face. Claimants to the above four improvements unknown.

### Instrument.

This survey was made with a Brandis and Sons mining Transit, No. 2005. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 50 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

### Report

The lode lines of these two locations were run direct upon the ground, and the corners established by means of offsets from the lode lines.

The traverse from the section corner to Cor. No. 1 is submitted in a separate report herewith. The N.E. Cor. Sec. 4, T. 31 N., R. 42 E. of M.D.M. is a limestone set in the ground and 6 x 8 ins. by 8 ins. above ground, and chiseled with 3 notches each on E. and W. edges, and with a mound of stone, 2 ft.
