The E. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 33, T. 32 N., R. 42 E. of M.D.M. is an iron post, 16 ins. high, set in the ground with mound of earth and stone, stamped $33 \frac{1}{4} | 34$ and with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2.5 ft. high, alongside.

Sur. No. 4197, Honey Comb lode.

Cor. No. 4, identical with Cor. No. 5.

Sur. No. 4197, Honey Comb No. 2 lode, is a pine post, 4 ins. square, 3 ft. high, set in mound of earth and stone, scribed H.C. 4-4197 and H.C. 2-5-4197.

Cor. No. 5 is a x ft corner point and H.C. 5-4197, chiseled on S. face of a limestone cropping, 2 x 5 ft. by 16 ins. above the general level, and with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high on W. side.

The E. side center of the location, Honey Comb No. 4 lode, identical with N.W. Cor. of the location, Honey Comb No. 5 lode, is a rock monument, 3 ft. base, 3.5 ft. high, marked E. Side Center Honey Comb No. 4 lode, and N.W. Cor. Honey Comb No. 5 lode.

The N.E. Cor. of the location, Honey Comb No. 5 lode, is a cedar post, 4 ins. dia. 4 ft. high, set in mound of stone, and marked N.E. Cor. Honey Comb No. 5 lode.

The E. side center of the location, Honey Comb No. 5 lode, is a rock monument, 3 ft. base, 4 ft. high, marked E. Side Center Honey Comb No. 5 lode.
