The $\frac{1}{4}$ section Corner between Sections 15 and 16 is a Andesite Stone with $\frac{1}{4}$ chiseled on West face and mound of stone west of corner near it are two witness trees blazed and scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 16 B.T. This is the nearest standing corner of the public survey that can be found and identified on account of snow drifts.
