

The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate of the Nona and Isabella lodes with regard to the courses of the vein, the courses of the boundary lines and the situation of the discovery points are due to errors of the latter.

The S. W. Cor. of Sec. 27, T. 20 N., R. 19 E., M. D. B. and M. is a stone 8x5 inches, projecting 12 inches above ground, chiseled with three notches on E. edge and one notch on S. edge and witnessed by a mound of stone west of corner with  $\dagger$  on top for exact point for connections.

No bearing objects available.

I could not find the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of the east and south boundary of said section 27.

There are no other improvements of value.
