COLCHIS MILLSITE.

- bears S.76°26'E. 491.5 ft. from Cor. No.1. Course of long side is N.87°E. Value, \$300.00
- No.2, The S.W. corner of the Store House, 10' x 16 ft., bears S.76°34'E. 535.0 ft. from Cor. No.1. Course of long side is N.87°E. Value, \$200.00
- No.3, The N.W. corner of the Coal House, 6 x 14 ft., bears S.73°59'E. 568.0 ft. from Cor. No.1. Course of long side is S.3°E. Value, \$40.00
- No.4, The N.W. corner of the Black Smith Shop, 14 x 18 ft. bears S.71°08'E. 566.0 ft. from Cor. No.1. Course of long side is N.87°E. Value, \$150.00
- No.5, A tunnel, 4 x 6 x 20 ft. long, the mouth of which bears S.49°00'E. 340.0 ft. from Cor. No.1 and tunnel runs thence South 10.0 ft. to a point, thence S.45°E. 10 ft. to face. This tunnel is used for a powder magazine. Value, \$150.00

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Keuffel and Esser Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on polaris, the details of which are returned herein. The distances were measured with a 200 and a 50-foot steel tapes.

REPORT.

The 1/4 Sec Cor. on the north boundary of Sec. 14, T.4 S., R.56 E., M.D.B. and M. is a lime stone, 18 x 12 x 8 ins., marked 1/4 on top. It lies on top of a large
