

A cabin, the north east corner of which bears from Cor. No. 1. $S 51^{\circ} 55' W 565$ ft. 12×16 ft. Course of long sides $N 15^{\circ} E$.

Developed springs and corral, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 1 $S 32^{\circ} E 31.50$ ft.

Instrument

This survey was made with an Ainsworth transit. The courses were deflected from the true Meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Report

All courses and distances of this survey were run direct upon the ground.

The S. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of Sec. 35 T. 18 N. R. 30 E. M. D. B. and M. is a basalt stone chiseled $\frac{1}{4}$ with mound of stone. Salt Wells Station bears N. about 400 ft.

Cor. No. 1 Sur. No. 4231 Banner Placer is a pine post 4 ins square showing $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft above ground.
