

Cut, westerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 2, Robert Emmett No. 3 lode, S 26° 45' E., 306.0 ft., 4 ft. wide, 6 ft. deep, running N. 80° E., 45 ft. to easterly end.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates of the lodes in this claim are due to errors in the latter.

Report.

The 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the west boundary of Sec. 33, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B. and M, is a stone 6X6 ins., 10 ins. above ground, marked 1/4 on the north face.

Course of line between the N. W. Cor. Sec. 33, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B. and M, and the 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the west boundary of said Sec. 33 is S 0° 43' E., 2642.0 ft.

After diligent search I was unable to find the S. W. Cor. of Sec. 33, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B. and M.

All corners of Amended Sur. No. 2276, are posts properly scribed with their respective corner and survey number.

N. E. Cor. Messina lode, Uns., and the N. W. Cor.

Stromboli lode, Uns., is a post marked N. E. Cor. Messina lode and N. W. Cor. Stromboli lode.

N. W. Cor. Sicily lode, Uns., is a post marked N. W. Cor. Sicily lode.

S. W. Cor. Sicily lode, Uns., and N. W. Cor. Mediteranean lode, Uns., is a post marked S. W. Cor. Sicily lode, and N. W. Cor. Mediteranean lode.
