

## REPORT - - continued.

The east  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 24, T. 25 S., R. 58 E., M. D. M. is a malpais rock, 8 ins. x 10 ins., showing 15 ins. above a flat mound of earth and stone, chiseled " $\frac{1}{4}$  S" on east face. This is the nearest standing corner of the public survey that can be found and identified. No other corners or  $\frac{1}{4}$  corners to either Section 23 or Section 24 can be found.

## Santa Clara lode, unsurveyed:--

All corners mentioned herein are pine posts, 4 ins. square, properly set and marked with description of the corner.
