lines from N. E. Cor. Section 34, T. 24 S., R. 57 E., M. D. M. to Cor. No. 1, Boss Extension lode and to Cor. No. 1, Saturday lode were run directly upon the ground.

The N. E. Corner of Section 34, T. 24 S., R. 57 E., M. D. M. is a lime stone, averaging in size, 5 inches thick, 11 inches wide and showing 16 inches above a small mound of lime stones, chiseled 2 notches on east face and one notch on south face. This is the nearest standing corner of the public land survey that can be found and identified. The N. W. Corner of said Section 34 and the east $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 27, T. 24 S., R. 57 E., M. D. M. was searched for but could not be found.
