Other Improvements.

Upper 4 ft. of the discovery cut of the Sierra Nevada lode, designated above as improvement No. I, comprising 240.0 cu ft. Claimant unknown.

Northerly section of cut, designated above as improvement No. 4, comprising 220.0 cu. ft., claimant unknown.

Shaft, which bears from Cor. No. I, Lode lode, N 46° 20' E., 380.0 ft., 4X8 ft., 400.0 ft. deep, claimant unknown.

Tunnel, mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 4, San Jose lode, N 9° 05' W., 182.0 ft., 5X6 ft., running N 50° E., 70.0 ft. to face, claimant unknown.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100.0 ft. and 500.0 ft. steel tapes.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates of the lodes of this claim, are due to errors in the latter.

Report.

S. W. Cor. Sec. 28, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B. and M, is a porphyry stone, 10X12 ins. 12 ins. above ground, marked with one notch on the south and four notches on the east faces, respectively.

All corners of the lodes of Sur. No. 2149, are posts properly scribed for their respective corner and survey number.
