Other Improvements.

Cut and tunnel, face of cut which is mouth of tunnel bearing from Cor. No. 4, S 21° 00' W., 366.5 ft. Cut is 6 ft. wide, 10 ft. deep, running S 80° E., 40.0 ft. to easterly end. Tunnel 5X7 ft., running N 80° W., 60.0 ft. to face.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

N. E. Cor. Sec. 35, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B. and M, is a stone 12X12 ins. setting in mound of stone, marked with one notch on the south and east faces, respectively.

Cor. No. 6, Sur. No. 2387, Gipsy Queen Lode is a post, scribed 6-2387.
