INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger and Sons No.4 transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The N.E.Cor Sec.27,T.2 N.,R.42 E.,M.D.M.to which connection is herein given consists of a stone showing 7 x 12 x 12 ins.above ground in mound of earth and stone,marked 2 notches on east side and 2 notches on south side and X on top.

Connection was made to this corner for the reason that it was the nearest corner that could be identified.

The N.E.Cor.Anchor Leland No.2 lode, unsurveyed, consists of a post 4 ins.square showing 3 ft.above ground in mound of earth and stone, marked N.E.Cor. Anchor Leland No.2.

The N.W.Cor.Anchor Leland No.3 lode, unsurveyed, consists of a post 4 ins.square, showing 3 ft.above ground in mound of earth and stone, marked N.W.Cor. Anchor Leland No.3.

All lines and connections were run direct upon the ground.
