

Cor.No.3 Gordon No.2 lode S 60 W 547 ft. 16x20 ft.

A stone and frame building the north corner of which bears from Cor.No.3 Gordon No2 lode S 52°W 747 ft. 23x30 ft. Course of long side S 58°51'W.

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INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C.L.Berger mining transit, No.7328. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. the distances were measured with 100-ft and 660-ft. steel tapes.

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REPORT.

The lode line of each location of this claim was run either directly upon the ground or with intermediate stations, and the several corners established by means of offsets. All tie lines were run either directly upon the ground or by traverses, run upon the ground and submitted in a separate report herewith.

The N.W.Cor.Sec.19, T 10N., R 44 E., M.D.M. is a granite stone with three notches chiseled on the south side, three notches chiseled on the north side, and a cross chiseled on the top to designate the exact point, 6 x 12 ins., showing 14 ins. above the ground.

U.S.L.M.No.190 is a pine post set on the apex of Stebbins Hill, 6 ins. square, showing 2½ ft. above a mound of rock 8 ft. in diam. and 3 ft. high, scribed U.S.L.M.No.190.
