established by means of offsets from the lode lines. The tie line from Cor. No. I, Valentine lode, was run directly upon the ground to the east  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 24, T. 25 S., R. 58 E., M.D.M. All other ties to  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner were computed by traverses extended through the other lines of this survey.

The east  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of Sec. 24, T. 25 S., R. 58 E. M.D.M. is a malpai rock, 8 ins. x 10 ins., showing 15 ins. above a flat mound of earth and stone, chiseled " $\frac{1}{4}$ " S" on east face. This is the nearest standing corner of the public survey that can be found and identified. No other corners or  $\frac{1}{4}$  corners to either Sections 23, 24, 25 or 26 can be found.

All corners mentioned herein are pine posts, 4 ins. square, properly set and marked with a description of the corner.
