

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with an Ainsworth Light Mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 700 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

All tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The NE, Cor. Sec. 16, T. 31 N. R. 43 E. of M. D. B. & M. is a granite stone, chiseled with three notches on east face and four notches on south face.

The NW. Cor. Sec. 22, and the SW. Cor. Sec. 15, T. 31 N. R. 43 E. of M. D. B. & M. are iron posts properly set and marked.

Sur. No. 3742, Tip Top and Hoosac Lode & Co. lodes. All corners porphyry rocks, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find all courses and distances to be correct as reported.

Sur. No. 3074, Stella May and Gilt Edge lodes. All corners are pine posts properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find all courses and distances to be correct as reported.

Creaser lode, unsurveyed. All corners are pine posts, scribed with the name of the claim and the corner.

Note; The location certificate of the Dart lode is in error as regards the calls northerly and southerly from the location monument, and the field notes give the same as staked upon the ground.
