Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificate of this claim are due to errors in the latter.

Report.

S. W. Cor. Sec. 26, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M, is a stone, marked with two notches on the east and one notch on the south faces, respectively.

Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 3880, Merger No. 1 lode is a stone, chiseled 1-1-3880.

Cors. No. 4, Maryland and Brandywine lodes, both of Sur. No. 2400, and Cors. No. 1, Big Nell Fraction lodes, both of Sur. No. 4306, are posts, properly scribed with their corner and survey numbers.

Other Improvements.

Out, mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 1, N 59° 15' W., 302.0 ft., 5.5 ft. wide, 5 ft. face, running N 10° E., 35.0 ft. to face, claimant unknown.

Out, mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 1, N 59° 45' W., 337.0 ft., 5 ft. wide, 5 ft. face, running N 15° E., 12.0 ft. to face, claimant unknown.

Shaft, which bears from Cor. No. 1, N 68° 58' W., 463.5 ft., 4.5 X 5.5 ft., 15.0 ft. deep, claimant unknown.
