

## Survey No. 4386

The shaft being situate in close proximity to the Royal lode advantage can be had of the equipment and machinery at the shaft for developing and exploring the territory of the Royal lode at these depths and extracting the ores therefrom at comparatively moderate expense.

## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A shaft which bears from the location post S. 60° W. 5 ft. 5 x 7 ft., 15 ft. deep.

A house 24 ft. square the north corner of which bears from Cor. No. 3 S. 6° 53' W. 273.2 ft Course of N.W. and S.E. sides S. 27° W.

## INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a No. 4 Berger and Sons Transit. The courses were deflected from the true Meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 500 ft. and 100 ft. steel tape.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificate are due to errors in the latter.

## REPORT.

The S.W. Cor. Sec. 28, T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M. D. M. to which connection is herein given consists of a stone 10 x 12 x 12 ins. in mound of rock, markings illegible.

Cor. No. 4 Sur. No. 2149 Nettie lode consists of a post 4 ins. square showing 3 ft. above ground in mound of earth and stone marked 4-2149.

Cor. Nos. 1 Sur. No. 4337 Sierra Nevada and Lode lodes consists of a stone 8x12x14 ins. above ground in mound of earth and stone chiselled SN1, L1, 4337.

The intersections with section lines were calculated using the official records of the Township field notes.
