Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

Report.

The S.E. Cor. Sec. 28, T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M. to which connection is herein given consists of a stone 5x10x14 ins. in mound of rock, chiselled 3 notches on east side and 1 notch on south side.

Connection is given to the above corner for the reason that it is the nearest corner whose position can be satisfactorily determined. The E  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. of Sec. 28 does not now occupy the position as shown by Survey No.4143 Eliza Jane lode.

Cor. No.4, Sur. No. 4143 Eliza Jane lode consists of a post 6 ins. square, showing 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. above ground in mound of earth and stone, scribed E J 4-4143 and P 6-4143.
