Other Improvements.

A shaft house and blacksmith shop all in one building, the southwest corner of which bears from Cor. No. 4, Anchor Leland No. 3 lode, N 9°E- 340 ft., 30 ft x 30 ft. Course of sides, S 45°E.

This building contains both an electric hoist and compressor.

The survey of each lode of this survey is iden-

tical with the locations and amended locations as staked upon the ground.

The disagreements between these field notes and the location and amended location certificates in regard to the courses and distances are due to errors in the latter.

Instrument.

The instrument used was a C.L.Berger light mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured by a 500 ft. steel tape.

Report.

The lines of this survey were run directly upon the ground.

The NE. Cor. of section 27, T.2 N.,R.42 E., of M.D.M. is a stone 10 inches x 12 inches x 10 inches high, marked with a x on top, with two notches on the east and two notches on the south sides, respectively.

The west 1/4 corner of section 27, has been moved from its original position.

Cor. No. 6, Sur. No. 4383, Mammoth No 2 lode, is a 4x4 post, 4 ft. long, scribed, 6-4383-M-2.
