

Report.

All corners establishing the conflicting lines of Surs. No. 2012, 2170, 2177, 2179, 2192, Sand Grass, Cash Boy. Golden Anchor, Triplet and Deming lodes, respectively are posts properly scribed with their respective corner and survey numbers, with the exception of Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 2012, Sand Grass lode, which is a stone chiseled 1-2012.

N. W. Cor. Sec. 35, T 3 N., R 42 E.. M.D.B and M, is a stone marked with two notches on the east and one notch on the south faces, respectively.

No. 1 Discovery cut, easterly end of which bears from Cor. No. 2, N 31° 00' W., 52.50 ft., 11 ft. wide, 5.5 ft. deep, running N 73° 00' W., 18.0 ft. to westerly end.

Value \$155.00.

No. 2 Shaft, which bears from Cor. No. 2, N 5° 15' E., 48.00 ft. 5x5 ft., 18.0 ft. deep, timbered.

Value \$380.00.

This survey was made with a Beyer transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.
