Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Note: The disagreements between these field notes and the originals and amended location certificates of the lodes of this claim are due to errors in the latter.

The S, W. Cor. Sec. 35. T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M, is a stone, marked with two notches on the east and five notches on the west faces, respectively.

Intersections with section lines were made in accordance with the approved field notes of T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M.

All corners of Sur. No. 4406, Operator et al lodes are posts, scribed with their proper corner numbers, together with the number of the survey.
