A frame bunk house the N.W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1,

Chico lode, of this survey, S. $40^{\circ}07'W$. 372.5 ft. 30.5x12ft., with

a 12x12 lean to built on the east side and lined up with the north

face. Course long side N. $11^{\circ}15'W$. Claimant herein.

A frame ore bin the S.E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1,

Jowiroha lode, of this survey, N. $26^{\circ}54'W$. 231.5 ft. 10.5x12 ft.

Course long side N. $4^{\circ}W$. Claimant herein.

A frame and canvass engine house the S.E. Cor. of which bears

from Cor. No. 1, Jowiroha lode, of this survey, N. $30^{\circ}20'W$. 112.5 ft.

10.8x35 ft. Course long side S. $88^{\circ}50'W$. Claimant herein.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with an Ainsworth light mountain Theodolite

Transit. The courses were deflected from true meridian as determined

by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 100

and 650 ft. steel tapes.

R E P O R T .

The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly

upon the ground and the several corners established by means of

offsets from the lode lines.

The N.W. Cor. Section 5, T. 5 N., R. 40 E., M.D.M., is marked by a

dark colored silicified rhyolite stone measuring 12x12x8x8 ins.

around and showing 12 ins. above a small mound of stone, chiseled

5 notches on the East face and 1 notch on the west face.

Diligent search was made for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner common to sections

5 and 6 of T. 5 N., R. 40 E., M.D.M. and for the south corner common

to these two sections but none could be found. Search was also

made for the south corner common to sections 31 and 32, T. 6 N., R. 40 E.,

M.D.M., but same could not be found.
