directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of off-sets from the lode lines. The section tie lines from Cor. No. 1, Last Chance lode, identical with Cor. No. 1, Last Chance No. 1 lode, and Cor. No. 1 Last Chance No. 2 lode, identical with Cor. No. 1 Last Chance No. 3 lode, were figured thru the lines of this survey. All other tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The N.W. Cor. Section 27, T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M., is marked by a light gray to pinkish rhyolite stone, loosely set in a mound of stone and earth 2 ft. high by 4 ft. in diameter at the base. Said rhyolite stone measuring 8x6x5 ins. at the base and running to a point on top and showing 14 ins. above said mound of stone and earth, chiseled 2 notches on the south face and 3 notches on the east face.

The west  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner Sec. 27, T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M., is marked by a light gray to buff colored silicified rhyolite stone, wedge shaped, 8x8x6x2 ins. at the base and running to a point on top, loosely set and showing 8 ins. above a small mound of stone and chiseled " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the east face. Said mound of stone is 6 ins. high by 2 ft. in diameter at the base.

The north  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner Sec. 28, T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M., is marked by a rhyolite stone, dark brown colored, measuring 14x6 ins. and showing 14 ins. above a mound of stone, loosely set, and chiseled " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the south face. Said mound of stone is 12 ins. high by 30 ins. in diameter at the base.

Survey No. 4143, Polo, Star Of The East, Eliza Jane and Desert King lodes :-

All corners mentioned herein, except Cor. No. 3 Polo lode, identical with Cor. No. 3 Desert King lode, are white pine posts, 6 ins. square, properly set and marked with a correct Cor. and Sur. number thereon. Cor. No. 3 Polo lode, identical with Cor. No. 3 Desert King lode, is a silicified rhyolite stone, brown colored, measuring 7x14 ins. and showing 6 ins. above the ground. Chiseled DK-3-4143 on the S.W. face and P-3-4143 on top.
