

Rye Patch No. 3 lode, S 71° 15' W., 370.00 ft., 18.5X36 ft., Course of long sides, N 45° 00' E.

Blacksmith shop, N. E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 3, Rye Patch No. 3 lode, S 76° 30' W., 422.00 ft., 10X12 ft. Course of long sides N 40° 00' E.

Transformer house, N. E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 3, Rye Patch No. 3 lode, S 88° 00' W., 365.00 ft., 8X12 ft. Course of long sides, N 45° 00' E.

All of the above improvements belong to claimant herein.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates of this claim are due to errors in the latter.

Report.

N. E. Cor. Sec. 27, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M, is a stone, marked with two notches on the east and two notches on the south faces, respectively.

All corners of Sur. No., 4396, Cleo No. I lode, Sur. No. 4400, Rye Grass No. I lode and Rye Grass Fraction lode, Sur. No. 4413, Cleo et al lodes and Sur. No. 4421, Cleo Extension lode are posts scribed with their proper corner and survey numbers.

All corners of Alberta lode, Kentucky lode and Chimney Fraction lodes, all unsurveyed, are posts properly marked with the name of the claim and the designation of the corner.

Intersections with section lines were made in accordance with the approved field notes of T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M.
