Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

All corners of Sur. No. 4364, Snowstorm No. 2 lode, Sur. No. 4388, Ivy Fraction et al lodes, Sur. No. 4396, Cleo No. 1 et al lodes, Sur. No. 4410, Mammoth No. 3 lode and Sur. No. 4413, Opal No. 2 et al lodes are posts properly scribed with their respective corner and survey numbers. N. E. Cor. Sec. 27, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M, is a stone, marked with two notches on the south and two notches on the east faces, respectively.

Intersections with section lines were made in accordance with the approved field notes of T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D. B and M.
