

## Expenditure of Five Hundred Dollars, continued.

No.2. A vertical shaft which bears from the southerly end of lode line of Owl No.2 lode, of this survey, N.30°30'W 57 ft., 5.5x11.5 ft. by 4 ft. deep. In loose rock.

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OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

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INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with an Ainsworth Theodolite Transit. The courses were deflected from true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 650 ft. steel tapes.

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REPORT.

The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode lines. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The S.E. Cor. Section 10, T.21 S., R.59 E., M.D.M., is a dark colored limestone 6x10 ins. showing 8 ins. above a small mound of limestone, chiseled 2 notches on the East face and 2 notches on the North face.
