OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A portion of a tunnel the entrance to which bears from Cor. No.1 N.39°30'E. 950 ft. running S.66°54'W. 880 ft. to face.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger and Sons Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 500 ft. and 100 ft. steel tapes.

Note: - The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

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The S.E. Cor. Sec. 28, to which connection is herein given consists of a stone 5x10x14 ins. in monument of rocks chiselled 3 notches on East and 1 notch on South side.

The intersections with section lines were calculated using the official records of the Township field notes of T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M.
