

## Other Improvements.

A tunnel the mouth of which bears from Cor.No.2 Nonpareil No.6 lode N.49°E. 54 ft. 4x6½ ft. running S.98°W. 15 ft. to face.

A shaft which bears from Cor.No.3 Nonpareil No.8 lode S.80°E. 255 ft. 5x5x10 ft.

## Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger and Sons transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 500 ft. and 100 ft. steel tapes.

Note: The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

## Report.

The S.E. Cor. Sec. 28, T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M. to which connection is herein given consists of a stone 5x10x14 ins. in monument of rocks, chiselled 3 notches on East and 1 notch on South sides.

The intersections with section lines were calculated using the approved field notes of T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M.

The S.W. Cor. Little Zoe lode unsurveyed is a post 4 ins. square showing 2½ ft. above ground in mound of earth and rock marked S.W. Cor. Little Zoe.

The S.W. and S.E. Cors. of Little Zoe Fraction No. 1 Lode unsurveyed are 4 in. square pine posts showing 2½ ft. above ground in mound of earth and rock marked SW and SE Cor. Little Zoe Fraction No. 1
