

A cut which bears from Cor. No. 1 Little Zoe Fraction lode N15°E. 760 ft. 4x8x6 ft.

A house the N.E. cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 4 Little Zoe Fraction lode S.80°E. 46 ft. 18x66 ft. course of long sides N.74°W.

A shaft which bears from Cor. No. 4 Little Zoe Fraction No. 1 lode S.35°44'W. 239 ft. 4x9 ft. 15 ft. deep

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger and Sons Transit-
The Courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 500 ft and 100 ft. steel tapes.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

The S.E. Cor. Sec. 28, to which connection is herein given consists of a stone 5x10x14 ins. in monument of rock chiselled 3 notches on East and 1 notch on South side.

The intersections with section lines were calculated using the approved notes of T. 2N., R. 42 E., M.D.M. Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 4437 Nonpareil No. 8 lode is a post 4 ins. square, 2½ ft. above ground in mound scribed 3NP8-4437

Cor. No. 4 Sur. No. 4437 Nonpareil No. 8 lode is a post 4 ins, square 2½ ft. above ground in mound scribed 4NP8-4437

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 4143 Ruby Hill lode is a post 6 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground in mound scribed RH3-4143

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 4143 Eliza Jane lode is a post 6 ins. square, 2½ ft. above ground in mound scribed EJ3-4143
