Tunnel 13.0 ft. long with 6 ft. face.

Cut 17.0 ft. long with 6 ft. face.

Face of cut and tunnel bears S. 40-00W.

INSTRUMENTS.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger Transit No. 8062.

The courses were deflected from a true meridian, determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with a 300 ft. steel chain tape.

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The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

The boundaries of this claim and the Lode line were run as indicated in these field notes, and all lines were run directly upon the ground.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between sections 12 and 13, T. 13N., R. 27E. M. D. B. is stone 4 in. by 6 in. by 15 in., set 8 in. in ground and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on North with mound stone 2 ft. base, by $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 3 ft. North.
