

12X15 ft. Course of long sides, N 10° 00' E.

Transformer house, southeast corner of which bears from discovery monument, Old Abe lode, N 65°30' W., 57.00 ft.,

5X10 ft. Course of long sides N 20° 00' W.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses and distances were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificates of the lodes of this claim are due to errors in the latter.

Report.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 26, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M, is a stone, marked with two notches on the south and east faces, respectively.

After making a diligent search I was unable to find the S. W. Cor. Sec. 26, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M.

All corners of Sur. No. 4109, Burger, Monte Carlo, Beehive and Independence lodes, which are mentioned in this survey, Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 4383, Red Dog Fraction lode, and Cors. No's 2 and 4, Sur. No. 4448, Morman Girl No. 2 lode, are stones properly chiseled with the initial of the claim, and the corner and survey number.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 4409, Close Fraction lode, Cors. No's 2 and 3, Red.Dog lode, and Cor. No. 2, Red Dog Fraction lode, both of Sur. No. 4383, are posts, properly scribed with the initial of the claim, and the corner and survey number.

Intersections with section lines were made in accordance with the approved field notes of T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M.
