INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger transit.  
The courses were deflected from the true meridian as de-  
termined by direct solar observations. The distances were  
measured with a 500 foot steel tape.

REPORT.

The lode line of each claim was run directly upon the  
ground and the several corners established by means of  
offsets therefrom.

All tie lines were run direct upon the ground.

The West  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of section 7 to which connection  
is given herein is a granite rock 1 ft. square showing  
15 inches above a mound of rock and marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ .

U.S.M.M.No.304 to which connection is given is  
a lime rock 2 x 2.5 ft. showing 1.5 ft. above the ground  
and marked U S M M No.304. with a X.on top.

Cor.No.5 Sur.No.4208 Rustler No.4 lode is a pine  
post 4 ins.square showing 2.5 ft.above the ground  
and scribed 5-4208 R 4.
