All lines of this survey of the Red Rose lode, and all the lines to conflicting and contiguous surveys, and the tie to the 1/4 Sec. Cor. between Secs. 3 and 34, T. 2 & 3 N., R. 42 E. M. D. B. & M. were made direct upon the ground; this 1/4 Sec. Cor. is a granite stone 18 x 6 x 5, in a stone mound, 4 ft. in diameter at base. This corner agrees with its location, as determined from the official record of sur. No. 4450 Birds Eye Extension lode.

Cors. Nos. 4 and 5, Sur. No. 2107 Utah, are pine posts, 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above the ground, scribed 4-2107 and 5-2107 respectively.

Cors. Nos. 1, 2 and 3, Sur. No. 4089 Wonder, are pine posts 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above the ground, scribed W-P-1-1-4089, W-2-4089 and W-SS-1-3-4089, respectively.

Cors. Nos. 1, 2 and 4, Sur. No. 4450 Birds Eye, are pine posts 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above the ground, scribed BE-1-4450, BE-2-4450 and BE-4-4450, respectively.

Cors. Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6, Sur. No. 4450, Birds Eye Extension lode, are pine posts, 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above the ground, scribed BE EX-1-4450, BE EX-2-4450, BE EX-3-4450, BE EX-4-4450, ~~BE EX-5-4450~~ and BE EX-6-4450, respectively.

Cor. Nos. 1-2107 Utah and 6-2088 Arizona was missing, its position being determined from its official record and is shown in accordance therewith.

I find the bearing and distance between Cor. No. 2, Sur. No. 4089 Wonder and Cor. Nos. 6-2107 Utah and 6-2088 Arizona to be N. 71° 53' E. 124.84 ft. instead of N. 72° 25' E. 123.7 ft. as approved.
