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Beginning at Cor. No. 1, identical with Cor. No. 1

Altitude Annex lodge of this survey.

A cross chiseled on the solid formation flush with the surface of the ground, and chiseled A-1-4470, AA-1-4470. This cross is 3.8 feet from the east face of a rhyolite dike 9.0 feet high.

Whence the $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. on the south boundary of section 34, T. 46 N. R. 58 E. M. D. B. & M., a rhyolite stone 18X10X5 inches, set 12 inches in the ground, marked dimly S. C. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the north face, (no evidence of pits or earth mound) bears S. $49^{\circ} 19' 25''$ W. 8554.64 feet.

A cross chiseled on the south face of the solid formation, 3.0 feet above the ground, and chiseled B. R. A-1-4470, AA-1-4470, bears N. $67^{\circ} 08'$ E. 15.73 feet.

No other bearing objects available.

Thence N. $20^{\circ} 14'$ W.

1500.00 To Cor. No. 2, identical with Cor. No. 4 Altitude Annex lodge of this survey.

A rhyolite stone 24X12X19X65 inches around the top, set flush with the surface of the ground, cross chiseled at the exact point; and chiseled A-2-4470, AA-4-4470, with mound of stone alongside.

No bearing objects available.

Thence N. $69^{\circ} 46'$ E.

600.00 To Cor. No. 3.

A rhyolite stone 34X18X16 inches set 15 inches in the ground, cross chiseled at exact point; and chiseled A-3-4470, with mound of stone alongside.

A cross chiseled on the solid formation flush with the surface of the ground, chiseled B. R. A-3-4470, bears S. $28^{\circ} 14'$ W. 23.16 feet.

No other suitable bearing objects available.

Thence S. $20^{\circ} 14'$ E.

A rhyolite stone 30X19X6 inches set 15 inches in the
