

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A tailings dam, the center of which bears S.38°45'W. 290 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Atlanta lode, size 45 ft. high with crest extending S.45°W. 90 ft. and N.45°E. 90 ft. from the center. Property of claimant herein.

Caved tunnel, the mouth of which bears S.65°08'W. 171 ft. from discovery October lode, probable size 4 x 6 ft. 100 ft. long. Property of claimant.

Caved incline, the mouth of which bears S.70°44'W. 240 ft. from discovery October lode, probable size 4 x 6 ft. 70 ft. deep. Property of claimant.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger Mining Transit No. 5107. The courses were deflected from a true meridian determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 650 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

Description of Corners. The Corner S.E. Cor. of Sec. 25, T. 13 N., R. 24 E. M.D.M. is a granite rock set in a mound of stone and marked with 5 notches on the north side and one notch on the south side.

Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 2913, Alameda lode is a 4 x 6 ins. post showing 3 ft. above ground in mound of earth and stone and scribed 1-2913.

The differences between these notes and those of the Location certificates is due to errors in the latter.
