

## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

## INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with an Ainsworth Light Mountain Theodolite Transit. The courses were deflected from true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

## REPORT.

The lode line of the location embraced in this claim was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of off-sets from the lode line. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground. The N.E.Cor. Sec. 27, T. 2 N., R. 42 E., M.D.M. is a rock chiseled 2 notches on the east face and 2 notches on the south face.

Survey No.4410, Mammoth No.3 lode:

All corners mentioned herein are pine posts, 4 ins. square, properly set and scribed as approved.

Survey No.4426, White Caps, White Caps Fraction and White Caps Fraction A lodes :-
