

A frame dwelling the N.E. Cor. of which bears S 27°E 99 ft. from Cor.No.1 Lucky Boy No.1 lode; 12x28 ft. Course of long side S 47°E. A shaft which bears S 25°E 96 ft. from Cor.No.3 Lucky Boy No.2 lode; 4x6x10 ft. deep in solid rock.

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INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Lietz Mining Transit No. 5262. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at eastern elongation. The distances were measured with a 660 ft. steel tape.

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REPORT.

The S.E. Cor. Sec. 22, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.M. is a rhyolite rock 4x6x10 inches set in a pile of stone with 2 notches on the east and south sides respectively.

The S.W. Cor. Sec. 22, T 2 N., R 42 E., M.D.M. is a rhyolite rock 12x9x5 inches set in a mound of stone with three notches on the east side and two notches on the south side.

Sur.No.4396 Opal No.3 lode.

All corners are pine posts 4 ins. square, showing two feet above a mound of earth and stone and scribed with the number of the corner and the survey. I find all courses and distances to be correct as approved.

Sur.No.4418 Snowstorm and Torpedo lodes.

All corners are pine posts 4 ins. square, showing two feet above a mound of earth and stone and scribed with the number of the corner and the survey. I find all courses and distances to be correct as approved.

Magnitude lode, Unsurveyed.

All corners are pine posts 4 ins. square, showing 2.5 ft. above small mounds of earth and stone marked
