## R D P O R T.

The S.W. Cor. of Sec. 31 is a granite rock 6  $\times$  8  $\times$  12 ins. above ground set in mound of stone with six notches on each of the four sides.

The other corners of the public land survey were not found after dilligent search and survey so the intersections given are calculated from the notes of the public land survey as given in the records of the office of the Surveyor General.

The differences between these notes and those of the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.
