REPORT.

The South 1/4 Cor. of Sec. 33, T.4 N., R.35 E. M.D.M. is a quartzite rock 4 x 6 ins. showing 14 ins. above the ground, in mound of rock, with 1/4 chiseled on the west face.

The S. W. Cor. of Sec. 33, T. 4 N., R. 35 E. M.D.M. is a quartz rock 10 x 10 x 18 inches above ground set in a small gulch, with mound of rock alongside. Marked with four notches on the east and two notches on the west faces.

The corners found standing of Sur. No. 1886, Melantius Laconia, Northern Belle No. 2 and Edina lodes, are 4 ins. square posts showing 3 ft. above ground in mound of earth and stone with survey and corner numbers scribed and the name of lode printed upon them.

The corners of the Foresight Lode are 4 ins. square posts showing 3 ft. above ground in mound of earth and stone with lode initials and corner number scribed thereon.

E R R O R S.

I find the following errors in the lines of prior surveys:--

U. S. Public Land Survey:-

The south boundary of Sec. 33, T. 4 N., R. 35 E. M.D.M. from S.W. Cor. to the 1/4 Cor. should read N.88°09'30"E. 2627.5 ft. instead of East 2640.0 ft. Sur. No.1886:-

Line 3-4, Melantius Lode, should read S.74°22'W. instead of S.74°18'W. as reported.

Line 4-1, Melantius Lode, should read S.2°19'W. 209.3 ft. instead of S.2°15'W. 200.0 ft. as reported.

Line 4-1, Laconia Lode, should read S.2°19'W.185.5 ft. instead of S.2°15'W. 200.0 ft. as reported. This may be
